Other Announcements

- (Mark) **County Convention.** We are holding our Regular County Convention in September. This will take place at our usual time and place, here at Doc's in Lebanon at 7:00 on the 11th of September. Important details:
 - All aspects of this convention will be in accordance with our by-laws, which are posted on our website
 - Go to our website https://warren.lpo.org/, click on About Us and Affiliate Records, then scroll to the 2022 constitution and by-laws near the bottom.

 - Important details
 - We should give **public notice** ASAP, but the requirement to give public notice is no less than 30 days. (**Action to the Secretary.**)
 - We cannot charge registration or attendance fees for this convention, as the 90 day requirement unless we decide to do it tonight and take action by tomorrow the 12th of June (I don't think we'd want to, anyways).
 - A **member** is defined as the following:
 - A. Has affirmed the following pledge: "I hereby certify that I do not believe in or advocate the initiation of force as a means of achieving political or social goals."
 - B. Is not legally affiliated with another political party.
 - C. Resides in Warren County, Ohio.
 - Who can vote? Delegates are defined as follows: persons that have affirmed the NAP, live within Warren County, are not legally affiliated with another political party, and have attended at least one business meeting of the Libertarian Party of Warren County or any county sponsored or supported event where attendance was taken between 25 to 365 days prior to the Convention in which the person wishes to serve as a Delegate.

- **Amendments** to our constitution must be provided by our July meeting, so that proposed amendments can be shared at least 30 days prior to the convention.
 - At the convention, proposed amendments must be approved by 60% of the delegates to pass.
 - Amendments take effect 48 hours after the convention, so amendments cannot change the way that this convention is run.
- **Officer Elections.** While not much is spelled out, we fall under the LPO's rules.
 - Nominations can be made at the convention, but we recommend nominating candidates by the August business meeting.
 - Voting will be accomplished using a run-off method requiring multiple votes eliminating the last-place candidate until a majority is reached.
 - All votes for candidates in the LP include "None of the Above" as an option.
